

2022 General Election Absentee Voting



Absentee voting for the November 8, 2022 General Election begins September 23, 2022 and runs through November 7, 2022.

Chisago County residents can absentee vote in-person at the Chisago County Government Center, 313 North Main Street, Center City, MN 55012 during regular business hours Monday through Friday beginning September 23 and running through November 4. The Government Center will be open for absentee voting Saturday, November 5, 2022 from 10 a.m.-3 p.m. and Monday, November 7 from 8:00 a.m.-5 p.m.

You can also absentee vote by mail. To request a ballot be mailed to you, an application is required. You can apply for your ballot:

- By completing an online Absentee Ballot Application at www.mnvotes.org and clicking "Other Ways to Vote"
- By printing a paper application from the County website and returning it to the Auditor-Treasurer's Office https://www.chisagocountymn.gov/140/Absentee-Voting
- By contacting the Auditor-Treasurer's Office and requesting an application be mailed to you.
