

Landscaping Ordinance Species List

Purpose

The Township requires installation of landscaping as part of any new development. To help guide the installation of appropriate landscaping, the Town has provided a policy of acceptable and prohibited trees for installation within the community. This list may be amended from time to time as new information becomes available.

Policy Language

The following is a list to prohibited trees that shall not be installed as part of the required landscaping associated with any new development project:

- 1. Ash (Fraxinus) unless documented that the cultivar is tolerant of emerald ash borer
- 2. Boxelder (Acer)
- 3. Buckthorn (Rhamnus)
- 4. Eastern Cottonwood (Populus)
- 5. Ginkgo Biloba (Ginkgo)
- 6. Lombardi Poplar (Populus)
- 7. Willow (Salix)

The following is a listing of trees species and the category they fall into for purposes of meeting the zoning ordinance landscaping requirements. This list is not meant to be an exhaustive list of the species that can be planted to meet ordinance standards.
